

Sandpoint Strikers Uniform Policy

When wearing the Sandpoint Strikers FC approved uniform and logo, our players represent more than 30 years of distinguished soccer heritage. Only uniforms approved by the Sandpoint Soccer Association (SSA) Board of Directors are to be worn by players in league and tournament play. All field players must wear identical uniforms.

Kochava is the exclusive uniform sponsor for all Sandpoint Strikers FC Club teams. Sandpoint Strikers FC is an Under Armour- (UA) sponsored club and the club is obligated to reflect the Under Armour brand at all times. All uniform kits are provided by and must be purchased from our uniform/apparel provider BSN Sports.

The uniform lifespan is estimated to be two-three years. At the end of this period, new uniforms will be a required purchase. Players are required to wear the most current version of our uniform to games. All coaches, staff, and SSA Board of Directors are to enforce this policy.

Game Day Uniform Requirements.

The approved uniform consists of two complete kits. Players can wear the branded shoe of their choosing.

- Red Uniform with Kochava front logo - Red UA jersey, UA black shorts, UA red socks
- Black Uniform with Kochava front logo - Black UA jersey, UA black shorts, UA black socks

All players are expected to bring both sets of uniforms to each match/tournament game. For league play, Red is worn for home games, but teams may have to change due to uniform conflicts.

Goalkeepers must wear Under Armour Uniforms with the Kochava logo or the SSA-provided Goalkeeper jersey. This jersey must be an alternate color to not conflict with the current Club uniform colors. Pinnies may be worn as long as the sponsorship logo does not conflict with the Club uniform sponsor.

Each player is responsible to pay for his/her uniform and it will become the property of the player. If a player damages, loses, or outgrows his/her uniform, he/she is expected to replace it with an identical uniform at his/her own expense.

Additional team shorts and socks and can be purchased via our uniform supplier, BSN Sports. Under Armour Club-approved warm-ups are optional at this time but can be purchased via BSN sports.

The SSA Board of Directors will vote on and approve new uniforms at its discretion. The lifespan of a uniform is typically dictated by the availability of the design by the manufacturer.

Training.

Players are not currently required to wear specific sponsored gear at training. If a sponsor becomes available, all players would be required to wear assigned practice gear.

Players must wear soccer-appropriate attire to all training. This includes soccer shorts/sweats, socks, and shin guards. Pants are not allowed.

PLAYERS WHO DO NOT ADHERE TO THE UNIFORM POLICY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN GAMES OR TRAINING.
